She conducts applied research on language, communication and social intervention and has taught at University of Massachusetts, Lesley College, and Emerson College in Boston. She has authored numerous publications, is the editor of the popular book *Teaching Children with Autism: Strategies to Enhance Communication and Socialization* (Delmar Publishers, 1995), author of the bestseller *DO-WATCH-LISTEN-SAY: Social and Communication Intervention for Children with Autism* (Brookes Publishing, 2000), and was a major contributor to the development of AutismPro.

Kathleen is on the editorial board for *Journal of Autism and Developmental Disorders* and *Focus on Autism and other Developmental Disabilities*; the Advisory Board for the *Autism Spectrum Quarterly*; the Board of Directors for Autism Asperger Publishing Company, and is the Director of the Professional Advisory Board of AutismPro.
